This IL provides industry notification of the impending split of the 215 NPA.

We have been advised by Bell of Pennsylvania that substantial telephone number growth in the Philadelphia, Pennsylvania area necessitates splitting the existing 215 NPA (area code) and the simultaneous introduction of a new 610 NPA. Both NPAs will have interchangeable central office codes (i.e., the second digit of a central office code may be any digit 0-9).

The new 610 NPA will serve primarily Lehigh, Berks, Delaware, Chester, Northampton Counties and a portion of Montgomery County. The 215 NPA will continue to serve the city of Philadelphia, Philadelphia County, substantially all of Bucks County and the remaining portion of Montgomery County.

The split of the 215 NPA is scheduled for 2:00 AM Eastern Daylight Time, Saturday, January 8, 1994. The permissive dialing period will begin at 2:00 AM Eastern Daylight Time, Saturday, January 8, 1994 and end at 2:00 AM Saturday, January 7, 1995. During the permissive dialing period either 215 or 610 will be acceptable in a dialed number terminating in the new 610 NPA. After the permissive period, calls dialed with incorrect NPA codes, as defined in the NPA split information published in the Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG), will be routed to intercept. Changes in the local exchange routing information, based on data provided by Bell of Pennsylvania, will be incorporated into the LERG and the NPA NXX Activity Guide (NNAG) and will be available June 1, 1993.

Central offices in the area to be served by the 610 NPA will be modified on a progressive basis to transmit "610" in the calling number Automatic Number Identification (ANI) between January 14, 1994 and May 27, 1994. Bell of Pennsylvania will convert all pertinent records to 610 the weekend of May 27-30, 1994. This includes customer service records and associated NPA information in other systems. After May 30, 1994, all inquiries must refer to the correct NPA code.

Test calls to verify routing to the new NPA can be made by calling 610-293-0052. This test number will become available on December 1, 1993, and remain operational until February 7, 1995.

The attached map illustrates the 215 and 610 configuration after the split. A list of the communities to be served by each NPA is also attached.

The dialing plan for the new 610 NPA will be the same as the existing dialing plan for the 215 NPA:

- All home NPA (HNPA) "local" calls (generally calls that do not incur a charge) will be dialed on a 7 digit basis with no prefix; i.e., NXX + XXXX (7 digits).
- All home NPA (HNPA) direct dialed "toll" calls (generally calls that incur a charge) will be dialed on a 7 digit basis with no prefix.
- All foreign NPA (FNPA) direct dialed calls must be dialed with a prefix "1" and 10 digits; i.e., 1 + FNPA + NXX + XXXX (1 + 10 digits).
- Operator assisted calls including credit card calls, collect, and third party calls will be dialed with a "0" prefix and 10 digits; i.e., 0 + NPA + NXX + XXXX (0 + 10 digits).


