Subject: Changes to Extraordinary NPA-Specific Conservation Procedures for 215 and 717 NPAs

(Pennsylvania)

We have been notified by Bell Atlantic, the administrator for Pennsylvania's Numbering Plan Areas (NPAs), that the extraordinary NPA-specific conservation measures for the 215 and 717 NPAs, previously announced in Bellcore Planning Letters PL-NANP-055 and PL-NANP-041, respectively, have been modified. The modifications involve a reduction in the rate of NXX assignments to three per month instead of the six or seven per month as described in the above PLs. In accordance with Section 8.5 the CO Code Assignment Guidelines (document INC 95-0407-008), NANPA is to advise the industry of any new conservation procedures that have been developed. Therefore, the attached document describes the new conservation measures for the 215 and 717 NPAs.

EXTRAORDINARY NPA-SPECIFIC CONSERVATION MEASURES FOR THE 215 and 717 NPAs

- Except as provided in Step 3 below, a maximum of 3 NXX codes will be assigned each month through November 1997.
- During the first 5 business days of each month each company/service provider may submit its request for no more than 1 code.
- 3. If less than 3 codes are requested during the month, the codes not requested will be added to the 3 codes available for the following month.
- 4. If more than 3 companies/service providers apply for codes per Step 2, the Code Administrator will use a lottery to determine the order in which codes will be assigned. The first 3 companies/service providers will be assigned codes in the current month. Only the remaining companies/service providers will receive codes in the subsequent month(s) until each company/service provider requesting codes in the current month has been assigned 1 code.
- 5. Requests for codes from a future month's allocation of 3 codes will not be accepted in advance of the first 5 business days of the month.
