Subject: Extension in the Permissive Dialing Period for the 508 and 617 NPA Relief Plans (Massachusetts)

We have been advised by Bell Atlantic-North, the administrator for the 508 and 617 Numbering Plan Areas (NPA), that the Massachusetts Department of Public Utilities has approved the extension of the permissive dialing period for the relief of the 508 and 617 NPAs by one month to January 1, 1998. The original relief plans for the 508 and 617 NPAs, as described in Bellcore Planning Letters PL-NANP-068 and PL-NANP-069, respectively, both called for the permissive dialing period to end on December 1, 1997.

In addition, Bell Atlantic-North notes that the exchanges in Watertown and Belmont, MA, previously scheduled to move to the 781 NPA, will remain in the 617 NPA. All other details of the 508 and 617 NPA relief plans as described in the above PLs remain unchanged.
