Subject: Urgent reminder to update networks for the 602 NPA Split in Phoenix, Arizona

with the new 623 and 480 NPAs.

It has come to our attention that some carriers and owners of PBX equipment may not recognize the new 623 NPA and 480 NPA resulting from the double split of the 602 NPA in Phoenix, Arizona. These two new NPAs were introduced in April 1, 1999 and will become mandatory on September 1, 1999. Please take steps to ensure that the 623 and 480 NPAs are recognized throughout your network.

Details of the split may be found in PL-NANP-152 issued February 1, 1999.

The latest information regarding routing to these new area codes may be found either in the Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG) or the NPA NXX Activity Guide (NNAG). Current information in the LERG and NNAG is available by license contract from Telcordia Technologies' Traffic Routing Administration (TRA) group, which can be contacted by dialing the TRA Hotline at 732-699-6700.
