Subject: Suspension of Relief in the 248, 313 and 734 NPAs - Michigan

In light of questions raised by the FCC regarding the authority of NANPA and the Michigan telecommunications industry to implement relief for the 248, 313, and 734 NPAs, NANPA will suspend relief in those NPAs. The relief schedule presented in Planning Letter 209 is no longer operative. In addition, requests for assignment of central office codes for the new 947, 679, and 278 NPAs will be suspended pending further direction by the FCC.

Unless the Michigan Public Service Commission notifies NANPA that it will exercise jurisdiction over this relief planning process, NANPA plans to file a petition with the FCC shortly. In the petition, NANPA will request FCC approval of the industry's recommended plan for relief of the 248, 313 and 734 NPAs described in Planning Letter 209. It is expected that the FCC will release a public notice requesting public comment on the industry's plan.
