Subject: Extended Permissive Dialing Ends for 516/631 NPAs (New York)

On January 31, 2000, February 23, 2000 and March 24, 2000 the State of New York Public Service Commission issued supplemental orders for CASE 98-C-0689 extending the permissive dialing period for selected NXX codes for the 516/631 area code relief plan. The extensions were granted to allow certain parties, such as alarm companies, additional time to reprogram equipment or otherwise prepare for implementation of area code relief. The orders extended permissive dialing through October 31, 2001.

This Planning Letter is being issued as a reminder that mandatory dialing of the 516/631 area codes with start on November 1, 2001 for the following NXX codes:

Mandatory dialing for all other codes in the 516/631 area codes became effective April 1, 2000.
