Subject: Extraordinary NPA-Specific Jeopardy Conservation Procedures

Announced for the 812 NPA (Indiana)

General Description

Because NXX code demand had increased beyond industry forecast, the 812 NPA is in jeopardy of exhausting before relief can be provided. According to the *Central Office Code (NXX) Assignment Guidelines* (document INC 95-0407-008, revision 9/27/02), "A jeopardy condition exists when the forecasted and/or actual demand for NXX resources will exceed the known supply during the planning/implementation interval for relief." The purpose of this notice is to announce that *extraordinary NPA-specific conservation* measures as defined in Section 9.3 of *the Central Office Code (NXX) Assignment Guidelines* have become necessary for the 812 NPA.

General Information

All remaining codes in 812 NPA will be rationed through jeopardy procedures adopted by industry consensus on October 8, 2002. Rationing will continue until implementation of a relief plan approved by the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission. The jeopardy procedures have been posted to the NANPA web site, www.nanpa.com.
