Subject: NPA 510 – Relief Plan Dismissed (California)

Related Previous Planning Letters: PL-206, PL-190

General Description

On April 1, 1999, in decision D-99-04-24, the California Public Utilities Commission approved an overlay for the 510 NPA and NANPA assigned the new 341 NPA (see PL-190). On December 16, 1999, in decision D-99-12-051, the CPUC indefinitely suspended the overlay (see PL-206). The 510 NPA however has been held in rationing by the CPUC and NANPA has kept it in jeopardy status.

On September 20, 2010, the CPUC eliminated the rationing for the 510 NPA thus allowing NANPA to rescind the jeopardy condition. Therefore, with the CPUC's May 3, 2007 decision (D-07-05-011) which determined that all previously filed requests for area code relief that remain pending are dismissed as moot, NANPA publishes this planning letter to reflect the NPA relief project for the 510 NPA as dismissed.

NANPA will retain the 341 NPA as the reserved future NPA for the 510 area code unless otherwise specified by the CPUC. When NANPA determines the 510 NPA is in need of area code relief a new project will be initiated and a new application for relief will be submitted to the CPUC.

General Information

The information in this planning letter reflects detailed information about NPA relief activities. The information has been derived from commission orders and from industry implementation decisions. The implementation of the plan described in this letter is the responsibility of individual service providers, and NANPA does not guarantee that the activities and plans will occur exactly as described herein.
