**Subject:** NPA 639 to Overlay NPA 306 (Saskatchewan, Canada)

Related Previous Planning Letters: PL-431

This Planning Letter adds three more NPA 639 Test Numbers for SaskTel (ILEC) to the list of previously identified Test Numbers. It also adds the Uranium City Exchange Area to the list of Exchange Areas shown in Attachment 2.

In Telecom Decision CRTC 2011-533, dated 26 August 2011, the Canadian Radio-television and Telecommunications Commission (CRTC) directed that relief for Saskatchewan area code 306 be provided through a distributed overlay using new area code 639 effective 25 May 2013.

The new area code 639 has been assigned by the North American Numbering Plan Administrator (NANPA) and will be implemented on the relief date of 25 May 2013 as a distributed overlay over the geographic area of the province of Saskatchewan currently served by the 306 area code. The area code 306 consists of 228 Exchange Areas serving the province of Saskatchewan which includes the major communities of Assiniboia, Esterhazy, Estevan, Humboldt, Kindersley, Maple Creek, Melfort, Melville, Moose Jaw, Moosomin, Nipawin, North Battleford, Outlook, Prince Albert, Regina, Rosetown, Saskatoon, Swift Current, Weyburn and Yorkton. A map showing the location of the area served by NPA 306, and a list of the 228 Exchange Areas in the area are attached to this letter.

Commencing on 25 February 2013, many calls dialled with 7 digits will first be connected to a network announcement notifying callers that the local number they have dialled must be preceded by its area code and that their call will now proceed after which the call will be completed. Carriers operating in NPA 306 that opt to employ a network announcement will phase in this network announcement during the period 25 February – 4 March, 2013 and maintain it until mandatory 10-digit local dialling is introduced on 25 May 2013.

When mandatory local 10-digit dialling begins, all calls dialled with 7 digits will be connected to a network announcement informing the caller that the number they dialled must be preceded by its area code, their call cannot be completed as dialled, and to hang up and redial using the area code. Carriers operating in NPA 306 that opt to employ a network announcement will phase in this network announcement during the period 11 May – 18 May 2013, and replace it by a standard network announcement starting between 26 August and 26 September 2013.

The dialling plan for the area served by NPA codes 306 and 639 will be as follows:

- All local calls, including Extended Area Service calls, originating within the 306/639 overlay area must be dialled with 10-digits; i.e., NPA-NXX-XXXX.
- Toll and alternatively billed calls originating within the 306/639 overlay area will continue to be dialled with 10-digits after the appropriate prefix digit(s).

All international and domestic Telecommunications Service Providers (TSPs) should ensure that the new 639 NPA is activated throughout their networks by 25 February 2013 which is the start date for network testing.

The following test numbers for the new NPA 639 will be made available effective 25 February 2013. Routing of calls to area code 639 can be verified by dialing the 8378 (TEST) numbers which do not provide answer supervision. Billing of calls to area code 639 can be verified by dialling the 2455 (BILL) numbers which provide answer supervision.

Calls successfully completed to test numbers will receive the following announcement:

"You have successfully completed a call to the 639 area code test number at [CARRIER NAME] in Saskatchewan, Canada."


The disconnection dates for the test numbers will be between 24 June 2013 and 24 July 2013.

Central Office (NXX) Codes within NPA 639 may be assigned to TSPs starting from 25 November 2012, but cannot be activated in the PSTN prior to the Relief Date of 25 May 2013.
